Summary:

IT Human Resource in Cambodia is increasing from day to day. However, all IT education schools haven't yet a standard teaching program because universities have different course contents. There are two kinds of IT teachers, a few foreign teachers and many Cambodian teachers. Most Cambodian teachers have graduated from various countries such as European countries, USA, Japan, India, Singapore, Thailand, Philippine, etc.

In this year, by getting support from World Bank, Council of Ministers of Ministry of Education Youth and Sport (MoEYS) have changed the year one university program. So the year one program of all universities must be the same foundation year. Foundation year must study subjects relate to philosophy, math, physique, history, and literature before they start profession skill subjects. Nevertheless, the quality of IT education is still low because most of private universities allow students to enroll bachelor course without doing an entrance test.

There are not so many job opportunities for recent graduated students because IT market of Cambodia is too small. This year, only 300 to 400 students of 2,000 graduated students can get a job. A small amount of students continue to get master degree in foreign countries, and some enroll master program in Cambodia.
